## A Computer Spreadsheet for Locating Assistive Devices

Clinicians involved in the selection of assistive devices for hearing-impaired people must rely on catalogs, brochures, and other materials for fitting and ordering information. Without some means of organizing all of the information that is collected, the device selection process may be prolonged and some available devices may be overlooked. This paper presents a product locator for organizing assistive device product information for rapid retrieval. The product locator is available in printed form in this article or the reader may request a spreadsheet form for either Macintosh or IBM-PC equipment.

Clinicians involved with the recommendation and distribution of assistive devices for hearing-impaired individuals often complain that they do not have a resource that provides them access to all currently available assistive devices. Retrieval of information needed when advising patients can be cumbersome and inefficient. In addition, information available from a given source may not be inclusive of all products from a particular distributor or all products that address a particular need. Finally, names and addresses of distributors often require updating.

In an effort to establish a complete directory of available assistive devices, as well as a means of rapid retrieval and updating of product and distributor information, a product locator was developed using spreadsheet software. Because of the availability of Apple Macintosh and IBM-PC equipment in the Northwestern University Hearing Clinics, both Excel and Lotus spreadsheet software was used.

All known sources of information on assistive device manufacturers and distributors were consulted. Requests for printed information were mailed to 140 suppliers. Suppliers were then eliminated if they had gone out of business or stopped supplying devices

for hearing-impaired individuals. The final list of 93 suppliers is shown in the Appendix. Collected materials were arranged alphabetically by manufacturer and placed in a three-ring binder. Access to these catalogs is an essential element of using the spreadsheet locator. After several appropriate devices are identified, the catalogs are consulted for specific information.

By using the catalogs, we created the product locator in Table 1. The product locator is used by finding the heading listed across the top of the table that describes the type of device you are looking for and then looking down the column directly below the heading. The categories of devices are: (a) alerting, (b) telephone, (c) TV/radio/stereo, (d) personal communication, (e) group communication, (f) emergency call system, (g) nonelectronic, (h) board displays, (i) tinnitus masker, (j) modified stethoscope, and (k) other. For example, devices for enhancing use of a television, radio, or stereo are grouped in the general category labeled TV/radio/stereo. Within this general classification, options include frequency modulated (FM), hardwired, infrared, direct audio input, induction loop, and captioning devices as indicated by FM-Wired-Infra-Direct-Loop-Caption sub-headings. The plus symbol (+) indicates that a particular device is available from a particular manufacturer/supplier. A special feature of this product locator is indication of companies that distribute for a variety of manufacturers. The "other" category, defined by numbers at the bottom of the table, allows identification of specialty items. Manufacturer/supplier names and addresses, not shown in the table, are included on the spreadsheet and can be used to produce mailing labels.

After we assembled the product locator, copies were mailed out to each manufacturer listed and verification of what we had identified on the table was requested. All but five manufacturers returned the forms indicating that our information was accurate or indicating appropriate changes. These changes were incorporated into the product locator in Table 1.

Spreadsheet software facilitates ease of updating the material, adding new manufacturers, deleting manufacturers that stop supplying assistive devices, adding symbols (+) for devices that a manufacturer adds to the product line, and adding new headings as new devices are developed. Each user should add the devices supplied by the local telephone company in his/her area. We find the spreadsheet to be a very convenient way to store the information, but all of the information, current as of October, 1988, is also presented in Table 1 and the Appendix.
