

Herbert J. Oyer presented a short course in Rehabilitative Audiology at the annual convention of the California Speech and Hearing Association. This meeting was held in San Francisco in March, 1969.

Herbert J. Oyer also reports the establishment of a laboratory in the Department of Audiology and Speech Sciences at Michigan State University that is solely for the purpose of making scientific studies in the area of aural rehabilitation. Several studies are in progress at this time.

A. Bruce Graham and Edward J. Hardick have been chosen to serve on the Advisory Council of the Michigan Hearing Aid Board. The establishment of the Board and the Council has occurred as a consequence of the passage of the hearing aid licensing law now in effect in Michigan.

Edward J. Hardick has been selected to attend a workshop on the "Verbo-Tonal System of Deaf Education" to be held in Columbus, Ohio, June 16-20, 1969. This is the terminal activity of a SRS demonstration project.
